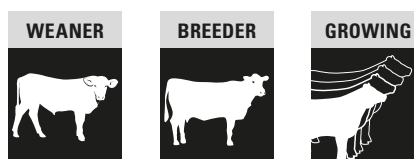

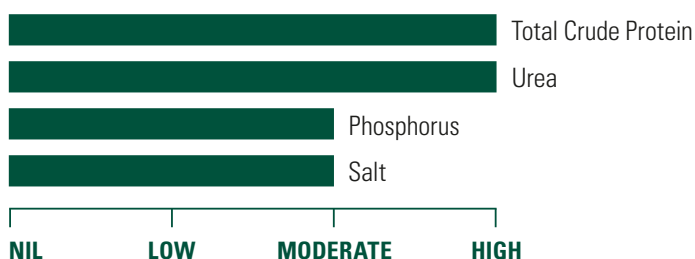

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

1. Mix 2 × 20 kg bags (40 kg) of Rumevite Molasses Fortifying Concentrate into 440 litres (600 kg) of molasses in open flat bottom troughs.
2. Ensure molasses and concentrate are well mixed.
3. Troughs should be licked clean prior to refilling.
4. Production feeding – allow stock free access to the balanced molasses ration while on pasture. When adequate pasture is available, intake will be approximately 1 – 1.5% of animal's liveweight per day.
5. Maintenance feeding – if the objective of molasses feeding is to maintain stock under drought conditions, restrict intake of balanced molasses ration to 0.5% of the animal's liveweight per day. This can be achieved by limiting the quantity fed.
6. Do not feed to stock in its present form. Mix with molasses as directed.

PRODUCERS SHOULD NOTE THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONARY RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Consumption should not exceed the level indicated on this label.
2. Should consumption exceed the level stated on this label please call 1300 666 657.
3. Always provide adequate clean drinking water.
4. Urea should not be fed to starving stock, malnourished and/or thirsty stock.
5. Risk of urea toxicity increases the closer blocks are placed to water.
6. Do not feed this product where roughage is inadequate.
